 - RISE (Summer Bridge; 300 kids): \$8320
 - SMILE (Summer Math Initiative for Learning and Excellence)
 - ELEVATE (Supports ELA): \$15,000 total for SMILE and ELEVATE
 - SMAC (Summer Math Acceleration Camp; 100 kids): \$14,000
 - Each has 4-6 teachers
 - Teachers may be interested in doing it, for \$60/hour assuming pay on time
